




Barouk Reserve Entrance

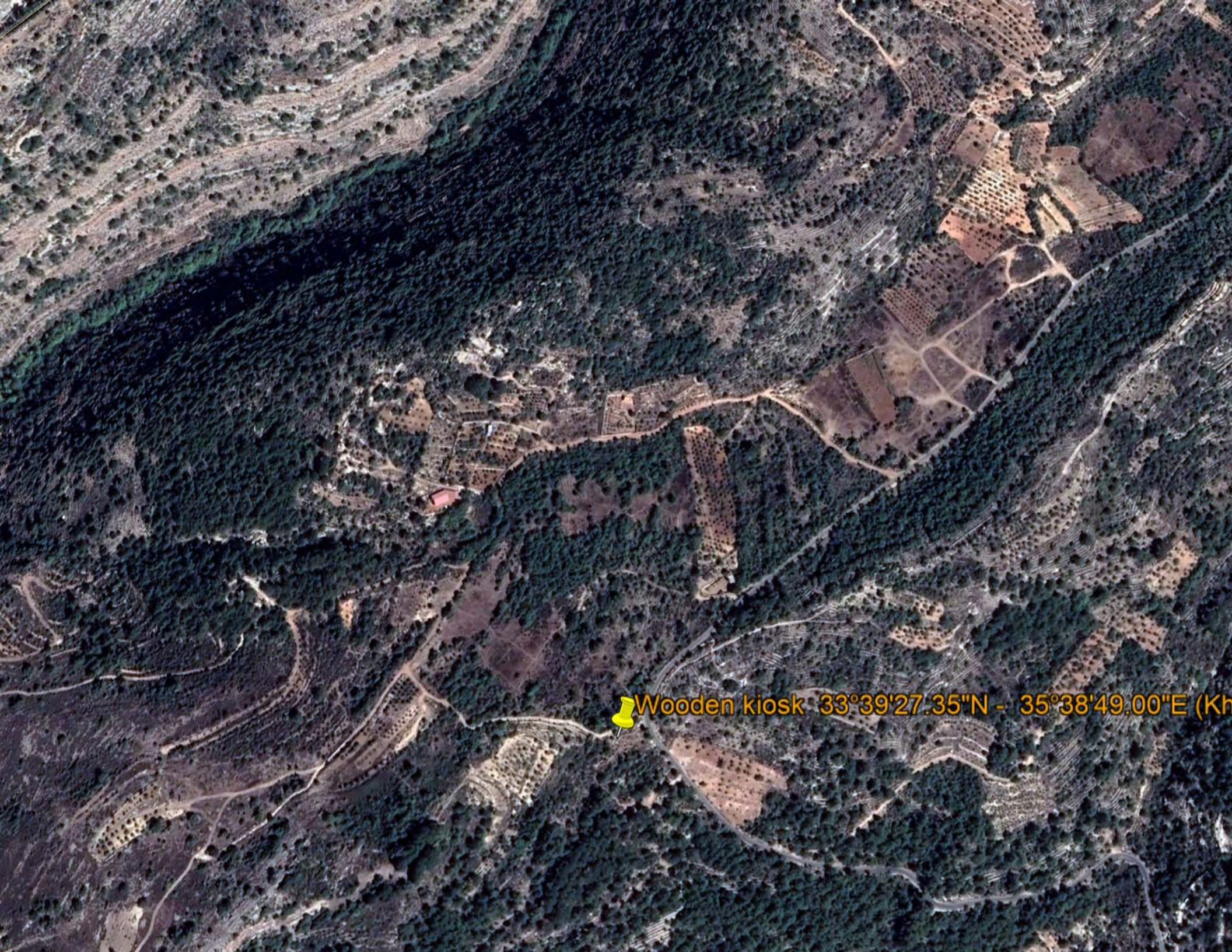


Wooden Kiosk (protection point) 33°44'55.05"N - 35°43'39.35"E (Ain Zhalta)
